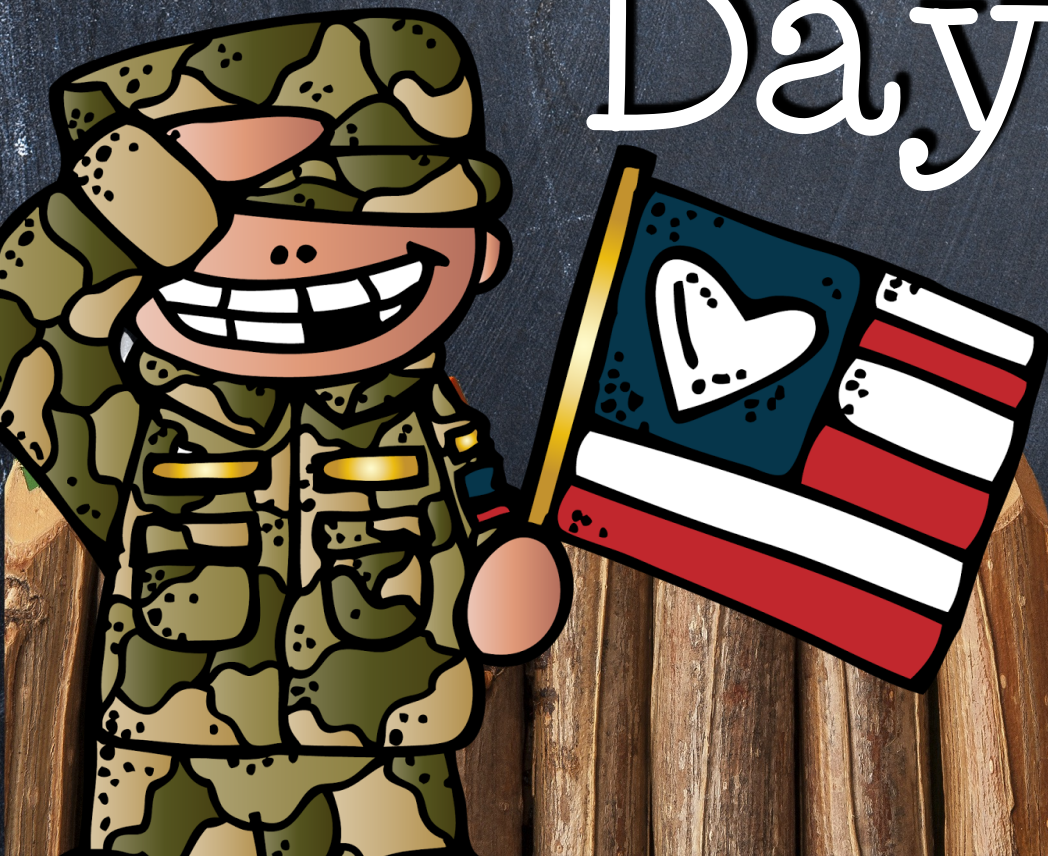

Let's Draw: A Veteran

Page 1

1. Have kids turn their paper long and tall



2. In the center of the page, draw a smile line



3. On top of it, draw flat smile line



4. Above that, add a side to side line



5. On one side, draw an up and down line



6. Draw another on the other side



7. Connect with a side to side line



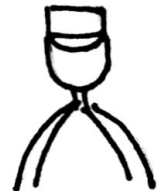
8. Under the smile line, draw two short up and down lines



9. From those draw a waterfall line down on each side



10. Add two more waterfall lines to the outside of them



11. Connect the inside lines with a side to side line



12. Add another side to side line above it



13. In the center of the two lines, add two up and down lines



14. Under the belt, add two short lines on each side, connect with a side to side line



15. Under the side to side line, draw a line down on each side. Connect them at the bottom with a side to side line



16. Draw a line up in the middle



17. At the bottom in the center, draw a short line down and over, then curve up and around to make a shoe



18. Repeat on the other side

19. Join the two outside waterfall lines with two short side to side lines in



20. Under them on each side draw five tight smile lines



21. At the top of the neck, draw a "v" and another "v" under it



22. Draw a line down to the belt



23. Under the belt, continue the line down



24. On the side of the line, draw dots for buttons



25. On the side of the buttons, draw a smile shape



25. Add a side to side line at the top, repeat on the other side



26. Draw two filled-in circles for eyes, a rainbow line nose, and a smile under it

27. Under the hat, draw two smile shapes over for hair

28. Add squiggle circles to the clothes for camouflage

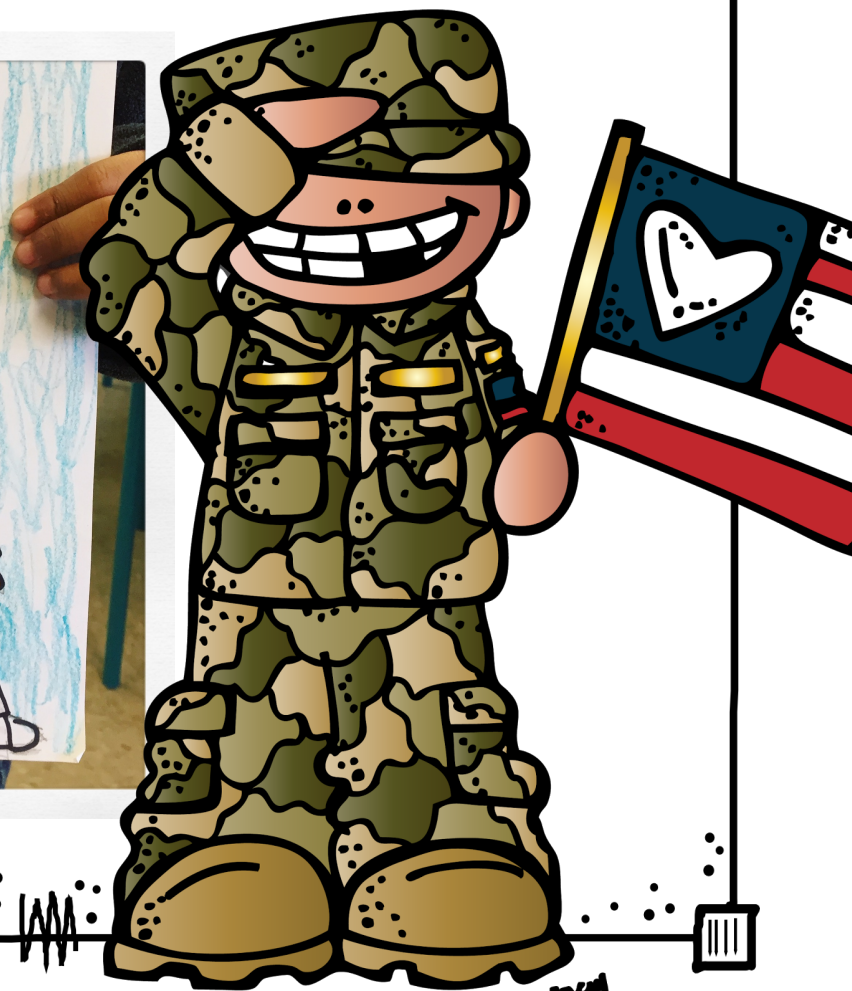
